A motion was made by Jody and seconded by Fritz to approve the meeting minutes of October 4, 2020 with one change. VOTE: 3-0

Mohawk Drive Through Clinic

The Mohawk Drive through Clinic was on Saturday October 17, 2020 with 427 vaccines being distributed and more than 200 cars.

COVID-19

Jody reported that there is one new case in Shelburne since the last meeting. There are 0-5 confirmed cases in the Town of Buckland with larger than normal number of contacts. Discussion on contact tracing.

Randy spoke about getting Halloween information into the Greenfield Recorder so families would be aware that roughly 80% of the village will have there lights off.

Jody thought that the Black Board connect call was very good and there was discussion on doing another call. One topic for messaging might be COVID fatigue and urging people not to let their guard down.

Observations from Columbus Day Weekend: Hager's Farm Market was very busy but looked as if social distancing was being practiced. Village was quite busy, but everyone seemed to be compliant.

Marti spoke about the new season bringing an uptick in cases and would like to keep communication open between both sides of the bridge.

Health Agent Updates

Davenport's Service Station tobacco permit expired – as of meeting that have applied.

Randy urged members to have board members do the SAPE Grant survey regarding the public health system.

COVID testing locations at the Community Health Center in Franklin County with no doctor order. Franklin Medical Center and Cooley Dickinson with a doctor order. There was further discussion on testing and doctor orders.

Zoning Board of Appeals Permit – Ashenden: A motion was made and seconded to have the Chair sign the permit and deliver it to Becky Ashenden. VOTE: 3-0. There was discussion on how to get the permit to Town Hall and to Becky Ashenden.
