## TIPS FOR SAFE WINTER TRAVEL

The safest choice this holiday season is to stay home and keep in-person celebrations to just your household.

Massachusetts residents are urged to limit out-of-state travel only to places designated as COVID-19 lower-risk. ## If you must travel, take steps to protect yourself and others from COVID-19:

- Wear a mask in airports and stations as well as on buses, planes and trains
- Wash your hands often or use hand sanitizer; use sanitizing wipes on surfaces
- **Avoid close contact** stay at least 6 feet apart from non-household members, try to avoid bag checking to minimize time in crowds or lines
- **Use contactless options as much as possible** e-tickets, online check-ins, use the provider's app to check gate information rather than gathering at departure boards
- Buy refundable/exchangeable tickets so you won't feel pressure to carry through if you start to feel sick

## **REMEMBER**

## All visitors entering Massachusetts, and returning residents are required to:

1. Complete the Massachusetts Travel Form prior to arrival, unless you are coming from a lower-risk state. Access the form online at: <a href="https://www.mass.gov/forms/massachusetts-travel-form">https://www.mass.gov/forms/massachusetts-travel-form</a>



2. Quarantine for 14 days or produce a negative COVID-19 test result that has been administered up to 72-hours prior to your arrival in Massachusetts.

If your COVID-19 test result has not been received prior to arrival, visitors and residents must quarantine until they receive a negative test result.
